**Text: Psalm 56**

1. Pressure and promise (1-4)
  - A. The pressure on David (Ps 56 title; 1-2). a type of Jesus X and His greater oppression
  
  - B. Singing and clinging to the promise as David did (3,4; cp 10-11):
    - 1) \_\_\_\_\_ is where faith rests.

    - 3) The outcome of the act of trust is \_\_\_\_\_.
  
2. The oppressors' zeal (5-7)
  - A. The anatomy of David's oppressors (complaints he makes against them, 5-6)
  
  - B. A good question about the sin of oppressors, a better answer (7)
  
3. The Protector's care (8-11)
  - A. Our God is \_\_\_\_\_ with our affliction -- the bottle and book of God (8)
  
  - B. Our \_\_\_\_\_ is God's triumph for us -- the power of prayer and Presence (9-11)
  
4. The danger past (12-13)
  - A. Keeping the promise(s) made in \_\_\_\_\_ (12a)
  
  - B. \_\_\_\_\_ the answered prayer and continuing Presence of our God (12b-13)
