The Tree of Life

In the Bible, trees are given to man for food and medicine as well as beauty and shade. Trees are an emblem of God's glory in the world and so are fitting symbols of God's people. We can flourish "like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither" (Psalm 1:3). The growth of the kingdom is likened to a rising, spreading tree (Ezek. 17; Matt. 13:31-32). Adam's fall severed us from access to the Tree of Life, but united to Christ we again have access to its life-giving fruit (Rev. 22:2). The Tree of Life is a symbol of Jesus. The time between Pentecost and Advent is called Trinity Season. The color green is used to symbolize life, growth, and the maturation of Jesus' kingdom.

- 1. The serpent's seed strikes again: What makes a ruler act violently toward his subjects?
 - A. Herod acts violently toward some from the church (1) Who is he? (heritage, character, reputation, motivations, leadership style)

B. Herod kills James the brother of John (2) Which James? Why is he killed?

- C. Herod imprisons Peter during Passover (3-4), but the church prays for him (5)
 - Peter's arrest explains further motivations of Herod (significance of Passover)
 - What men can do to our body vs what the Body can do for one another
