

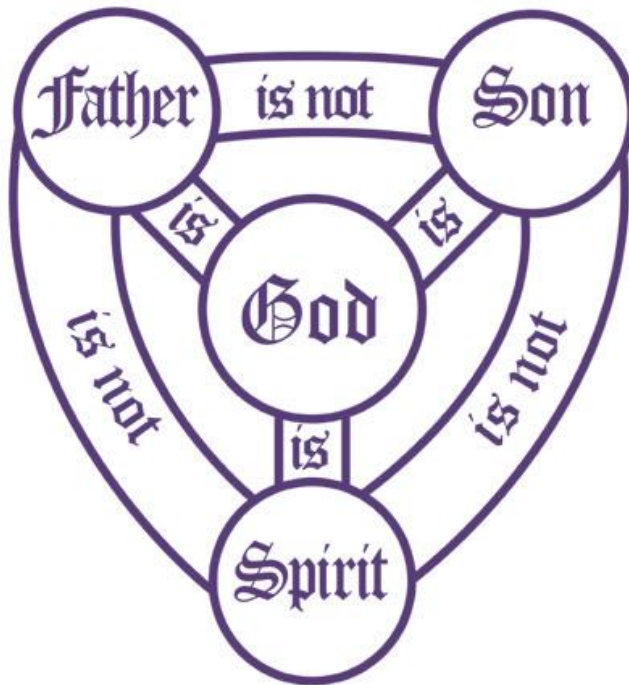

#### LORD'S SUPPER

We observe Communion, or the Lord's Supper, weekly in our midst.

We believe it is worthily received by those who:

1. Have been baptized in the name of the Triune God (Matt 28:18-20);
2. Do profess faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God, and Savior of sinners, and do rest upon Him alone for salvation as He is offered in the Gospel (Ro 10:9-10);
3. Do live in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit and endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Jesus Christ (Gal 5:16-26); and
4. Are communing members in good standing in an evangelical church (1 Cor 10:1-6)

If these things are all true, we rejoice with you and invite you to commune with us at the Lord's Supper. If any of these are not true of you, we ask that you refrain. We invite you to speak to one of the Elders if you have doubts or questions regarding any of these beliefs, or if you are interested in learning more about Trinity.

## Sermon Notes – June 11, 2017

### "Disturbing Prophecies from the Spirit" Text: Acts 21:1-14

1. From Ephesus to Tyre, Paul is warned by prophecies about going to Jerusalem (1-7)
  - A. Jesus headed to Jerusalem & suffered there for the \_\_\_\_\_. Paul does also.  
Does this mean each generation of the Church will have to suffer in the same way?
  
  - B. Being forewarned, was Paul \_\_\_\_\_ for going to Jerusalem?  
Does the Holy Spirit test us by working contrary to Himself?
  
2. At Caesarea, Paul is warned by a prophet about what would happen to him at Jerusalem (8-14)
  - A. Philip the evangelist & his prophesying daughters.  
How are these women an \_\_\_\_\_ to Christian women & their ministry in Christ's Church?
  
  - B. "Thus saith the Holy Spirit" & "The will of the Lord be done."  
Reconciling commendable \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_  
to the will of a good God.
