1.	Wicked Jews attempt to use the new magistrate to persecute
	A. "" Gallio? (12) His character & the general demeanor of Roman governors/ judges
	B. Paul is accused of practicing a <i>religio illicita</i> , an religion (13). <i>Contrary to what law?</i> Does being a Christian mean you are acting illegally according to the law & custom of the State?
2.	Christ, the Just Judge, uses the to advance His kingdom in Roman Corinth.
	A. Gallio contemptuously dismisses the accusation (14-15)
	B. Gallio dismisses the with contempt (16-17; Ps 7:9-11, 14-17).
	C. Paul is remitted to his work, freer and safer to do it than before (14a, 18a)
