## Study Notes – November 26, 2017

### "The End of Paul's Journey Is Our Beginning"

Text: Acts 28:23-31

- 23 explaining & testifying of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus  
23-24 *from morning till evening. And some were persuaded...and some disbelieved*  
25a So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed...  
25b *The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our fathers,*  
26-27 Hearing you will hear and shall not understand...  
28 *let it be known to you that the salvation of God has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will hear*  
29 And when he had said these words, the Jews departed and had a great dispute among themselves  
30 *Then Paul dwelt two whole years...and received all who came to him*  
31 preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ

1. The message is the \_\_\_\_\_. The point of the message is that Israel's God in \_\_\_\_\_ (Jesus) claimed His throne as Lord of the world (23, 31).
2. The people (\_\_\_\_\_) through whom God's message & Messiah (Savior) would come for the benefit of all (\_\_\_\_\_ too), distorted their calling for their own benefit (24,25,28,29,30)
3. This strange purpose of God (\_\_\_\_\_) was spoken by the Holy Spirit through Isaiah and is cited six times in the NT (26-27; Is 6:9-10)
  - A. \_\_\_\_\_ says Isaiah's prophesy was fulfilled as He spoke parables to Israel (Mt 13:14; Mk 4:12; Lu 8:10)
  - B. \_\_\_\_\_ says Isaiah's prophesy was fulfilled by the signs Jesus did before Israel (Jn 12:37-41)
  - C. \_\_\_\_\_ quotes Isaiah to explain the blindness of Israel (26-27; Ro 11:8)
