  C'. False teachers 2:10b-22
  B'. Reminder of the day of the Lord (3:1-13)
  A'. Encouragement to perseverance 3:14-18
- 1. What seems a delay in the coming of the Lord Jesus in power does not mean that \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the false teachers is reversed by the Lord (2:1, 3; Mt 24:48ff).
