	E.	1561-1598, wars between a 'kingdom within a kingdom' (Rev 11:7ff) 1572, St Bartholomew's Day Massacre 1598, Henry of Navarre issues Edict of Nantes, ending the wars 1685, Louis XIV institutes <i>dragonnades</i> and revokes Edict of Nantes;
