### Reformation Sunday

#### “The Church of the Desert; the Church under the Cross”

1. *From the midst of the burning bush.... “where you stand is holy ground” (Ex 3:4-5)*
  - A. Biblical \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ writings influenced the rise of the French Reformation, as did in...
  - B. 1533, a frail, international reformer: \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Co 1:27)
  
2. *The kingdom of heaven suffers violence (Mt 11:12); yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution (2 Ti 3:12).*
  - A. 1536-1538, a French apology to King Francis I of France: \_\_\_\_\_
  
  - B. 1540s, Mustard seed growth & increased repression under Henry II (1547-1559)
  
  - C. 1559, first national synod at Paris adopted the *Confessio Fidei Gallicana*; \_\_\_\_\_
  
  - D. 1560, French Protestants first known as ‘confederates of the oath’ or \_\_\_\_\_
  
  - E. 1561-1598, \_\_\_\_\_ wars between a ‘kingdom within a kingdom’ (Rev 11:7ff)  
1572, St Bartholomew’s Day Massacre  
1598, Henry of Navarre issues Edict of Nantes, ending the wars  
1685, Louis XIV institutes *dragonnades* and revokes Edict of Nantes; \_\_\_\_\_
  
3. *The wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous (Pro 13:22; cf Eccl 2:26).*
